INTRODUCTION

This publication provides statistical information to planners, educators, and employers regarding high school graduates in Tennessee. The data in High School Graduates 2009 are presented in a county summary table followed by statewide totals. Individual county tables are presented alphabetically.

The Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, in cooperation with the Tennessee Department of Education, conducts a survey of all schools that have enrollment in grades 9-12 and qualify to give a state of Tennessee diploma upon graduation. This includes all public schools, accredited private schools, and special schools in the state. The following tables list the number of schools and response rates as well as the number of graduates, their education, and current work plans or military service, if appropriate.

Special thanks are extended to school administrators and counselors who took time to answer this survey. Their cooperation will benefit the educators, employers, and planners across the state who use this publication.

HIGHLIGHTS

Tennessee's 2008-2009 graduating class attended the state's 399 public and private high schools. There are 56 city high schools, 258 county high schools, 82 private high schools, and three state special schools that constitute the universe of this survey. The special high schools are for the vision and hearing impaired. This survey includes all accredited high schools that had students that qualified for a state of Tennessee diploma.

Of the schools that responded to this survey, a little more than 8 percent (8.3 percent) of the 2009 graduates attended private schools. In general, a far higher percentage of graduates from private schools (98.0 percent) intend to continue their education than graduates from public schools (70.7 percent). The four largest urban counties (Davidson, Knox, Hamilton, and Shelby) accounted for 29.4 percent of all Tennessee graduates. Of the graduates in those four counties, 79.4 percent plan to continue their education. In the remaining 91 counties and the special schools, only 70.3 percent of the graduates plan on continuing their education. It must be noted that the survey response rate for the four urban counties was only 65.2 percent while the survey response rate for the remaining 91 counties was 85.8 percent.

The highest percentage of graduates continuing their education occurred in Williamson County (90.2 percent), Decatur County (90.7 percent), Cumberland County (90.0 percent), Hamilton County (87.4 percent), and Davidson County (85.5 percent). The lowest percentage of graduates continuing their education occurred in White County (29.9 percent), Scott County (30.0 percent), Lauderdale County (33.3 percent), Sequatchie County (35.5 percent), and Lake County (39.2 percent). Cannon, Houston, Lincoln, Overton, Pickett, Stewart, and Trousdale counties had no responses to this survey. It is not surprising that two of these counties (Lauderdale and Scott) had the second and third highest average unemployment rates in 2009. This is the second straight year that Pickett County schools have not responded.

A 72.9 percent response rate (323 schools) was achieved in this year's high school survey. The figures are not absolute measures; they represent the **intentions** of the 2008-2009 graduates. All data in this publication are **preliminary** accounts.

Graduates who did not fit into the categories of continuing their education, entering the labor force, or entering the armed forces were listed in the category of "other." These categories may not add to total graduates because of persons falling into more than one category (i.e., continuing education and entering the labor force).

NA represents "not applicable" and is used when we did not receive any survey responses for a particular county. Schools that responded to the survey but had no graduates will have zeroes in the data column but will be counted as a responding institution.
